

 you will be attending. This is necessary in order to secure your financial aid award from the school
 you will be attending as well as to get refunds of deposits from schools you will not be attending.
- Seniors, who have applied to colleges and have listed them on the FAFSA, should have received
 financial aid award letters from those schools. If you have not heard from such colleges, contact
 their financial aid office ASAP.
