

Tuberculin Testing of Students

Prior to entering the school district for the first time, all foreign born or previously foreign dwelling pupils, regardless of grade, are required to show evidence of a negative tuberculosis test result. In cases of a positive tuberculosis test result, pupils are required to provide a physician's statement certifying that the pupil is free from tuberculosis in a communicable stage. If the pupil is found to be ill with tuberculosis, the pupil will be excluded from school until such time that a physician's statement certifies that the disease is no longer in a communicable stage. Identified cases of tuberculosis shall be promptly reported to the county record bureau as required by state law.
