Final Grade Cards

Your child's final report card and cumulative transcript for the 2020-2021 school year were mailed Friday, June 4th.

Parents and students; Please look over these materials carefully.

The number of credits earned this year is reported on the grade card, along w/ the First Nine Weeks, Second Nine Weeks, Exam 1, Semester 1 Average, Third Nine Weeks, Fourth Nine Weeks, Exam 2, Semester 2 Average, and Final grades for all courses for this school year.

Final Grades, total credits, cumulative GPA, and class rank are reported on the transcript.

Generally speaking, students should earn a minimum of 5.25 credits per year in order to remain on schedule to graduate in 4 years.

Parents of students who failed required courses (did not earn a 65 or higher as a FINAL grade), are encouraged to contact Ms. Lewis as soon as possible to discuss make up options for those courses.

College Credit Plus

Students who will be taking college course work next Fall through the College Credit Plus Program must have a college schedule into the high school by June 17th. Schedules can be emailed and processed virtually.

This process is crucial to ensuring that students are enrolled in courses required for graduation. Once students have enrolled in CCP classes, they MUST submit a copy of their college schedule to the counselor's office. This MUST be done each term. CCP books and high school course availability may be affected if schedules are not turned in by the deadline

2021-2022 Schedules

Class schedules for the 2021-2022 school year will be mailed August 2nd. Schedule changes may be requested prior to the start of school, August 3-13th. Changes may also be requested the first week of school. All schedules will be finalized August 26th.

Change requests must have parent/guardian signatures.
